Does the sun shade meet one of the following definitions?

Umbrella

Umbrella means a collapsible shade for protection against weather consisting of fabric or other material placed or stretched over hinged ribs radiating from a central pole. An umbrella may not be anchored to the sand or ground by any device or mechanism other than one central pole and may not have any material hanging below the material which is placed or stretched over the hinged ribs.

Wind-Powered

Wind powered sun-shade means a fabric (no larger than 160 square feet) which is attached to one continuous pole that connects to the ground in no more than two locations and which provides shade by the use of wind. A wind powered sun-shade can have no more than two other anchor points such as lines secured by stakes or sandbag

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IMPORTANT

It shall be the responsibility of anyone using a sunshade device to ensure that it is safely secured/anchored in place.

Should an individual modify the manufacturer's intended configuration of the sunshade, they will be responsible if the device becomes unanchored/airborne.
